PMI Results Show Continuing Upward Trend in 8th Grade NJ State Assessment

CTL's Progressive Mathematics Initiative (PMI) was created by a group of four school districts participating in CTL's math grant initiative in 2009-2011. These districts have shown steady growth in student achievement at the 8th grade level as measured by New Jersey's NJ ASK standardized test results, the state's official mathematics achievement measure.

The four districts (Tabernacle, Mendham, Florence, and Egg Harbor city) continue to use PMI and provide regular feedback to improve the units.
